Ring 1- Starts at 9.30am sharp
Judges: Mr Philip Scott and Mrs N. Shuttleworth
Entry Fee: €12 per pony per class
Entry Fee for Deloitte High Jump and Olympia Qualifier: €20

Class 01 Yearling Colt, Filly or Gelding (Reg. Sire & Dam)

Class 02 Registered 2 and 3 year old Colts

Class 03 Registered 2 year old Filly

Class 04 Registered 3 year old registered mare

Class 05 **All Ireland Connemara Foal Championship Qualifier.** This class is open to both colt and filly foals, the progeny of Registered Sire and Dam. The final takes place at the Town Festival held in Portadown, Co Armagh

Junior Championship (1st and 2nd Prize Winners in each of classes 1, 2, 3, 4, 5)

Class 06 138cm and under mare 4yrs old and over (may be measured on the day)

Class 07 Best bay, black, dun, chestnut or roan pony (in-hand). Pony can be any age and sex.

Class 08 Registered Stallion 4 year olds and over

Class 09 Registered gelding 2 yrs and over

Class 10 **Midlands All Ireland Broodmare Championship Qualifier** (must have foal at foot)

Class 11 4-7 year old mare with/without foal at foot

Class 12 8 - 14 year old mare with/without foal at foot

Class 13 15 year old and over mare with/without foal at foot

Supreme In-hand Championship - Champion: €200 Reserve: €100
(1st and 2nd Prize Winners in classes 8-13 and Junior Champion and Reserve)

Class 14 **BSPS Mountain and Moorland Olympia Qualifier - Registered Connemara Ponies**

The top 2 ponies from this qualifying class are qualified to compete in the BSPS Heritage Show in October. They will be put into the Connemara breed category where in turn the Top 3 ponies will then qualify for the Final in December at Olympia. Full rules on this class will be posted on our website. Class will be run under IPS rules.

Class 15 **Deloitte High Jump.** This class is open to Registered ponies, 5 year old and over. Riders must have attained their 14th birthday on the 1st January 2011. This is a high jump competition where a fence will start at 90cms and go up in height every round. If a pony knocks a pole they are eliminated. The winning pony will be the one that clears the highest fence.

Ring 2 - Starts at 11am sharp
Judge: Frank Burke
Entry Fee: €25

Class 16 3 year old Connemara Loose Jumping Qualifier – Final at Clifden

This competition is open to registered Connemara Ponies, in possession of a CPBS passport, aged 3 years. Ponies must measure 148cms or under, an allowance of 1cm will be made for shoes. All ponies entered will be measured at qualifying centres.

No boots or bandages are permitted. Plaiting of manes and tails is not permitted.

The fences at the qualifying centres will be a maximum of 97.5cms x 97.5cms (3'3" x 3'3").

The fences at the final will be a maximum of 101cms x 101cms (3'6" x 3'6").

Each fence will be scored out of 10. Potential will be scored out of 20. Total maximum points =100.

The Minimum number of points required to qualify for the Final will be 60.

The Final will be held on Wednesday 17th August at 2pm.

The Judge's decision is final. No pony owner should approach the Judge.

Ring 3 - Performance Classes - Starts at 9.30am sharp
Judges: Sarah Challinor and Denise Norton
Entry Fee: €15 per pony per class

Working Hunter classes will be run on a 50/50 marking basis. The pony will jump a course of fences and immediately do their ridden piece and confirmation for the second judge. The winning pony is the one with the highest combined score. The pony will jump a course of fences in Ring 3 and immediately head to Ring 4 for their ridden display and confirmation with the second judge.

Class 17 Reg. Connemara Working Hunter 4yrs and over. Rider under 16 yrs on Jan 1, 2011

Class 18 Reg. Connemara Working Hunter 4yrs and over. Rider over 16 yrs on Jan 1, 2011

Working Hunter Championship (1st and 2nd placed ponies in classes 17 and 18)

Champion and Reserve working hunter champions qualify for the Supreme Ridden Championship which will take place in Ring 1.

Horseware Search for a Star

These new classes have been introduced to showcase some of the most talented upcoming performance ponies. Ponies are required to jump a track of fences followed by the judge sitting up on the pony and giving them a walk, trot and canter on each rein. The jumping will not exceed 80cm for the 4 year olds and 90cms for the 5 year olds. Martingales and boots are not permitted.

Class 19 **Horseware Search for a Star – 4 year olds.** This class is open to 4 year old Registered ponies with riders any age. Ponies that come 1st to 5th will qualify for the **Irish Connemara Green Hunter Final** at Clifden show.

Class 20 **Horseware Search for a Star – 5 year olds.** This class is open to 5 year old Registered ponies with riders any age.

Horseware Search for a Star Championship - Open to 1st and 2nd placed ponies in Classes 19 and 20. The champion and Reserve Champion qualify for the Supreme Ridden Championship

Class 21 The **Power's Quarry International** Registered Connemara Pony Championship qualifier. Rider must be under 18 on the 1st January 2011. Ponies will jump a selection of 2-4 fences from the course and height will be up to 90cms. Martingales and spurs are prohibited. Ponies will be judged on type, confirmation, jumping technique, way of going, and action in-hand.

Ring 4 - Ridden classes - Starts at 9.30am sharp

Judges: Paula Cullen and Sarah Challinor

Entry Fee: €15 per pony per class

*** Phase 2 of Classes 17 and 18 will take place in this ring prior to class 22 commencing ***

Class 22 Reg. Ridden Connemara Pony 4yrs and over. Rider under 16 yrs on Jan 1, 2011

Class 23 Reg. Ridden Connemara 4yrs and over. Rider over 16 yrs on Jan 1, 2011

Class 24 Registered Ridden Stallion 4yrs and over. Rider over 16yrs on Jan 1 2011.

Class 25 **Golden Oldies**. Rider must be 40 or over and Registered Connemara pony 4yr old and over. Passport may be required for rider!

Class 26 **Brightwells Ridden Connemara Pony 4 and 5 years old Championship**. Rider any age.

Ridden Connemara Championship (1st and 2nd placed ponies in classes 22-26)

Horsefirst Supreme Ridden Championship – This will take place in the main arena after all in-hand and ridden classes are complete. Champion and Reserve Champions from Ridden, Working and Search for a Star Championships eligible to qualify. Champion will receive products to the value of €200 from Horsefirst. Reserve champion will receive product to the value of €100

Classes 17, 18, 22 and 23 are qualifiers for Oughterard Show August 2011. One pony from each class will qualify for the Final.

Classes 22 and 23 are qualifiers for the Rosmeen British CPS Ridden Final in the UK. Details below.

£100 First prize & Rosmeen Perpetual Trophy for the winner at the final

Ridden Show, Warwickshire Agricultural College, Moreton Morrell, Warwickshire.

This class is for Registered Connemara ponies not exceeding 148cms.

Exhibitors must be a member of the BCPS or the Connemara Pony Breeders Society in order to compete at the final.

Special Prize: A prize fund of €100 has very kindly been sponsored by Thornbrook Stud. This prize will be awarded to the mare who achieves the highest placings during the day in both ridden and working classes. Mares seeking to contend for this prize must ensure they declare on the entry form.

1. Entries close on **Thursday 24th May 2011**
2. All decisions in the format of this show are at the discretion of the Committee and all decisions are final.
3. All animals must be haltered including foals.
4. Judges decision will be final.
5. All entries must have registration number on entry form plus C.P.B.S. registration book must be available for inspection at Show.
6. The Committee accept no liability whatsoever for any damage, whether accidental or otherwise in respect of persons or property. Attendance or participation in Show implies acceptance of these rules.
7. All animals to be on the field at the commencement of judging.
8. Plaiting of manes and tails is not allowed in ridden or in-hand classes
9. The show committee would advise all animal owners to have their animals insured, to have their insurance extended to cover them while showing animals at shows. We understand that it costs very little or nothing at all depending on who you have your insurance cover with. If you are one of the few who don't have cover in place, we would advise you to think about putting it in place for this purpose as it may be worthwhile. The reason we are giving this advice is to protect you in the event of your animal lashing out and injuring someone or someone's property. If that were to happen, and it was established that your animal was out of control, you may be held responsible or partly responsible for any injury or damage caused and may end up paying all, or part of any settlement reached.
10. There will be a penalty fee of €5 for every late entry.
11. The Olympia Semi-Final qualifier will be run under IPS rules.
12. The show will be recorded by Horsebox.tv. Any pony or rider competing at Connemara Pony World might be used in footage both live on the day and after the show.
